

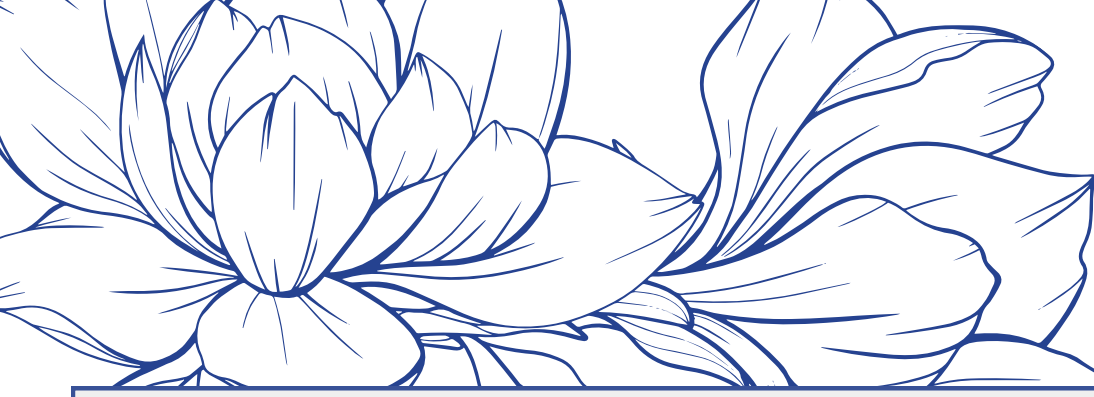

Dear Friends,

There is a paragraph in The Learning Project's Mission Statement that always strikes me as fundamental to the particular community that we seek to create as a school:

Our school is small—for a purpose. We are small in order to ensure a close relationship between each child and teacher, and to be a place where students feel secure in their environment and have opportunities to teach, learn, and socialize across age lines. The scale of the school enables a powerful sense of community to develop among students, faculty, staff, and parents, and a sense of involvement and caring that includes alumni, Board members, and friends.

When we talk about the “powerful sense of community” that makes students feel secure and opens opportunities for learning and growth, we are talking about *you*. You, the parents, faculty, staff, alumni, and friends are what make the work of The LP possible. It is because of you that The LP can make every child that walks through The LP's doors feel welcomed, be known, and learn and grow in a safe, nurturing environment. Thank you.

This year was another outstanding year financially for The LP. Most notably, we met our increased Annual Fund goal, raising just over \$350,000. And taking all of our fundraising efforts combined, the school raised \$582,611 in FY24. Your support over the last few years has allowed the Board to approve budgets for the school that rely on increased Annual Fund fundraising, allowing The LP to meet the realities of inflation and increased costs head on, without compromising our commitments to fairly compensating our dedicated faculty and staff, and to providing robust financial assistance to our families. We could not do this without you.

So again, thank you for all that you have done—and will continue to do—for our little school.

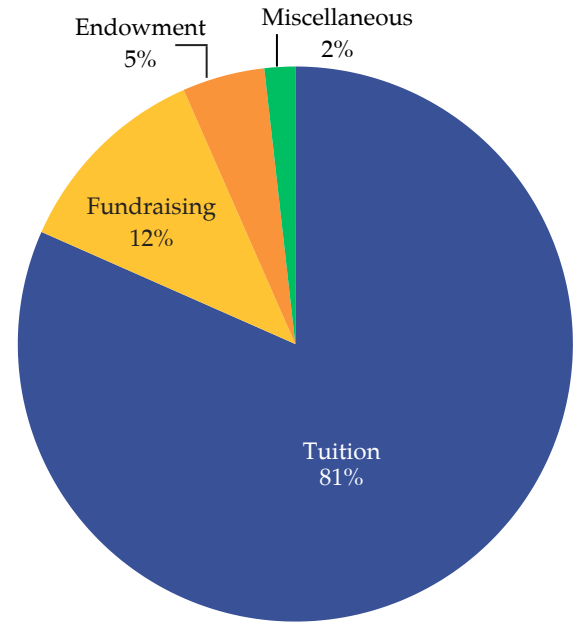

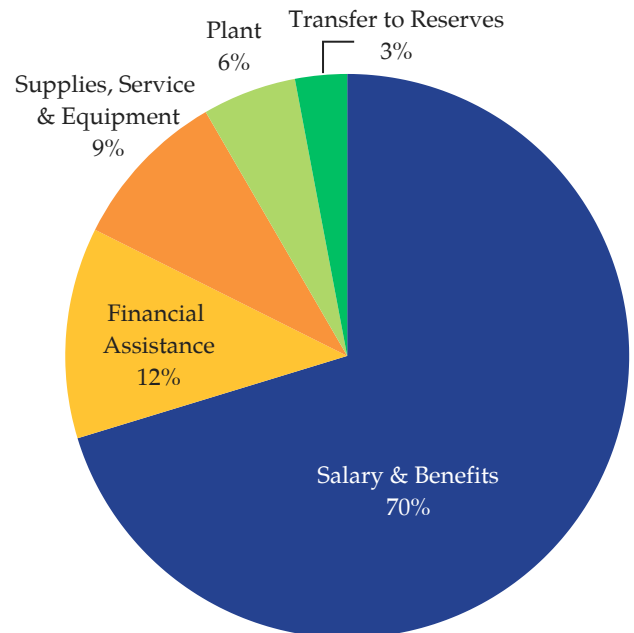

SOURCES OF OPERATING INCOME



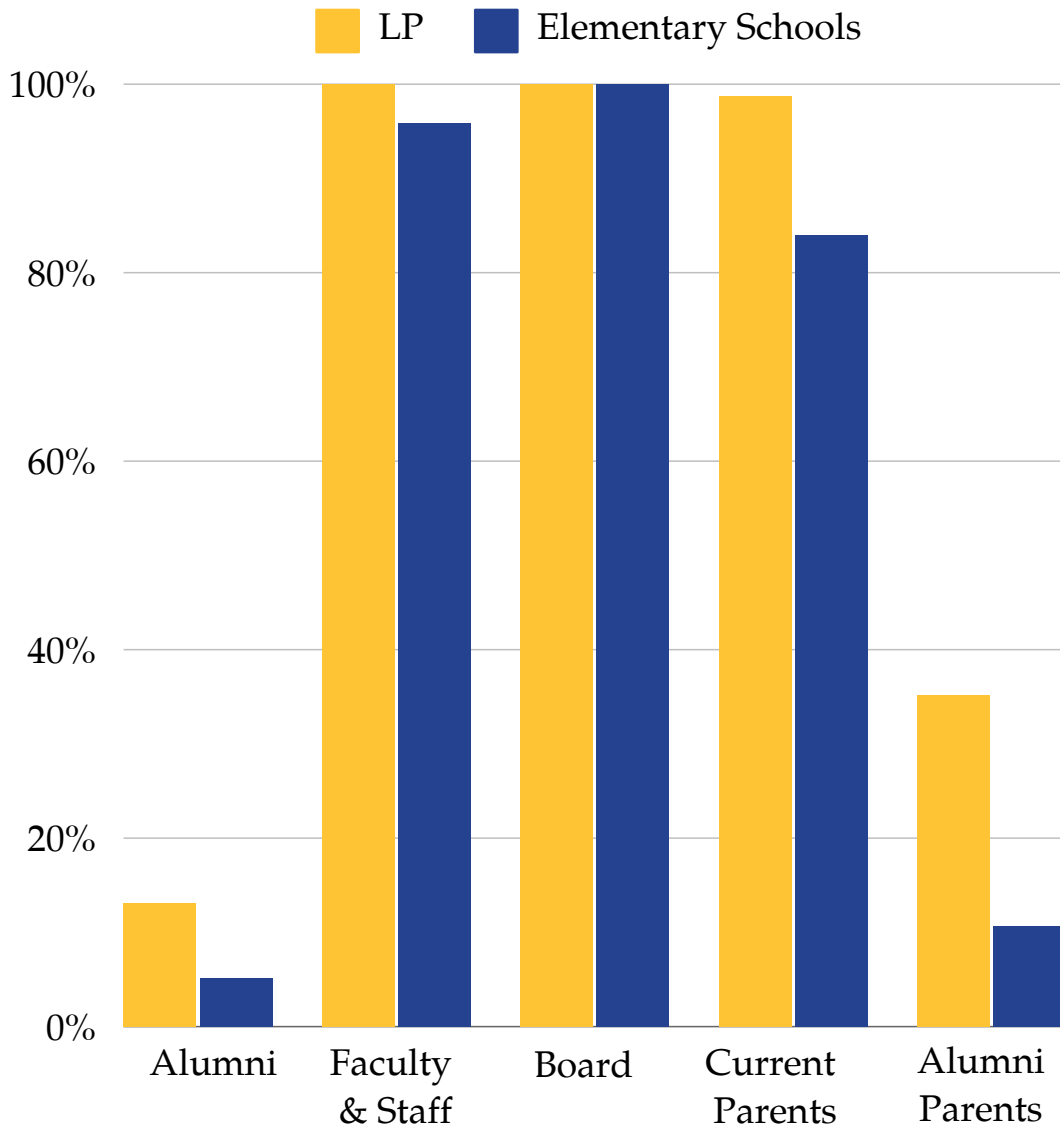
OPERATING EXPENSES
